


SUPERVISOR APP

SINGLE SIGN ON (SSO)

The Supervisor log in page now displays **SSO** as a sign in option.




If **SSO** is enabled for your business, the **SSO** sign in option will highlight, once a valid email address is entered.




Single Sign-On (SSO) is an authentication method that enables users to securely authenticate with **multiple** applications and websites by using just **one** set of credentials. This feature is now available for the MSite Supervisor App. If **your business** uses **SSO** the way you log in will be different.

After selecting **SSO Sign In**, authentication is required using your company's chosen authentication method. e.g. **Microsoft Authenticator**.



If using **Microsoft Authenticator**, you will be required to submit your password for the account.



And then **confirm** the authentication number to sign in. Once authenticated, you will be able to access the **Supervisor App**.
