



How to Add Lodgings to a Worker Profile.

Adding a **lodging address** and specifying which nights a worker stays in lodgings on their profile enhances the data included in the **CO₂ Travel to Site report**.

Lodging address information will also contribute to worker **Fatigue Management** solutions for your workforce.

If a worker has **multiple sites associated** to their profile, you can set **unique travel methods** and **lodgings** per site. Meaning you can get **accurate site-specific** data when running the aforementioned reports.

How to edit Lodging and travel to site information:*

Select **edit** on the specific site in the **Site Associations** section of the worker's profile.

Here, you can select:

- **Mode of Transport** – Can be site specific. Ensure to use the predominant method if multiple are used, i.e. If a worker drives a short distance to a station and then takes the train, select train as the means of transport.
- **Lodgings Postcode** – Enter in the postcode of the lodgings.
- **Nights in Lodgings** – Enter the nights in which the worker stays there to travel to site.

***Please Note:** This can also be completed during the process of **“Marking a Worker as Inducted”**.
