



How to Create a Fatigue Status Alert.

Follow this guide to create Fatigue Alert for workers.

A **Fatigue Status Alert** will inform the selected recipients if a worker infringes on **Fatigue Status** and will prompt the site team to action. The criteria for **Amber** and **Red** alerts is fully customisable to suit site requirements.

To **set up alerts**, from the taskbar, select:

Alerts & Notifications ➔ Alerts ➔ Add a Fatigue Status Alert

- **Sites** - Which sites would you like this **alert** to be applicable to. You can select all and set to automatically include new sites.
- **Contractors** - You can assign the alert to specific contractors, dependent on their **role on site**.
- **Roles** - You can choose which **roles** are covered by the alert.
- **Trigger** - Whether you would like the alert to cover **Amber** or **Red** status workers. You can select both status on the same alert.
- **Recipients** - You can select internal and external contractor recipients to receive the alert.

Add Fatigue Status Alert

This alert monitors the fatigue status of workers on site, on a contractor by contractor basis. Workers with an amber or red fatigue status will be flagged within the alert so that the site team can take action.
